

# Business

## THE PROGRAM

The Business program at Kishwaukee College prepares students interested in any area of business to transfer to a four-year college or university ready to enter the institution's Business College/School as a junior with the core business courses completed, including the mathematics, social sciences, English and speech traditionally required for junior standing as a business major. In addition, by completing the requirements for the Associate in Science degree at Kishwaukee College, students entering a four-year public university in Illinois will have fulfilled the General Education requirements at that institution.

A complete listing of all Associate in Art and Associate in Science degree requirements is available in the Kishwaukee College catalog. Students planning to transfer are recommended to check with the four-year institution to which they plan to transfer for course transferability and school requirements. Students are advised to meet with a faculty advisor/counselor to review credit transfers.

In addition to fulfilling the general education requirement for an A.A. or A.S. degree, the following courses are recommended for an emphasis in Business.
