

# Pre-Veterinary

## THE PROGRAM

The Pre-Veterinary program at Kishwaukee College prepares students interested in pursuing a degree in Pre-Veterinary Sciences at a four-year college or university with the long-term goal of admission to a College of Veterinary Medicine. The Kishwaukee College program consists of the core courses in biology, chemistry, physics and mathematics traditionally required in most bachelor's degree programs, as well as animal science coursework. In addition, by completing the requirements for the Associate in Science degree at Kishwaukee College, students entering a four-year public university in Illinois will have fulfilled the general education requirements at that institution.

A complete listing of all Associate in Science degree requirements is available in the Kishwaukee College catalog. Students planning to transfer are recommended to check with the four-year institution to which they plan to transfer for course transferability and school requirements. Students are advised to meet with a faculty advisor/counselor to review credit transfers.

## CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

With an A.S. in Pre-Veterinary, students are well-prepared to transfer to a four-year institution to continue their education.

In addition to fulfilling the general education requirement for an A.S. degree, the following courses are recommended for an emphasis in Pre-Veterinary.
